VIGIL OF THEOPHANY AND FEAST OF THEOPHANY

Vigil of Theophany (Epiphany, Jordan) January 5

Feast of Theophany January 6

Vigil of Theophany is celebrated January 5. Traditionally this evening is referred to as "Little Christmas Eve". It is observed with the same solemnity as Christmas Eve, with the faithful abstaining from meat at a festive Supper. The custom of singing Christmas Carols is continued at Theophany with the addition of special Theophany songs called "Shchedrivky".

Following the evening Divine Liturgy water will be blessed in preparation for the next day. During the service the priest's incensing of the water symbolizes the Holy Spirit's descent upon Jesus at the time of His baptism in the river Jordan. Later in the service 3 candles are immersed into the water. This symbolizes the destroying and forgiving of our sins through Jesus' baptism. After the service the faithful are invited to take some of the Holy Water to drink and to take home with them. (*News* "737" 1986) This year at St. Nicholas, Water Blessings will occur at the 7pm Evening Liturgy on Monday January 5, 2026, as well as the 7am and 10am Liturgies on Tuesday January 6, 2026.

Individual bottles of holy water will be made available for parishioners to take home the following Sunday.
